DIAGNOSTIC EVALUATIONS 2025

From April 7th to 11th, students from middle and high school participated in comprehensive diagnostic evaluations in the subjects of Mathematics and Language. These assessments mark a key moment in our continued efforts to improve academic quality and student performance.

Designed by two expert teachers with experience in each subject area, the evaluations were structured to measure both knowledge retention and learning styles, helping us understand where students are academically after the start of the school year.

These results are now being used to launch two important internal initiatives:

- 1. Teacher Training & Development to strengthen instructional techniques and adapt teaching to student needs.
- 2.Student Reinforcement Program aimed at supporting students through targeted interventions and guided support sessions in key academic areas.

This is the first step in a larger, multi-phase process of improving our academic model—ensuring that every student receives the support they need to succeed.

REAL-WORLD LEARNING BEGINS: INTERNSHIPS FOR FUTURE HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

In April, the students of 11th grade of High School with a Diploma in Nursing and Medicine took a major step forward in their vocational journey by officially beginning their internship. They are attending the Bethania Rehabilitation Center, where they will be completing 100 hours of hands-on experience in the area of physical therapy and rehabilitation. This real-world training allows our students to apply their knowledge in a professional setting, while also learning to work alongside medical staff and interact with patients.

The internship experience is not only a graduation requirement—it's a critical component of FAM's mission to ensure students leave the Institute with cal, employable skills and a clear sense of purpose in their chosen fields.
