VOCATIONAL ORIENTATION FOR FAM 12TH GRADERS (S)

Going to college and pursuing a career is not often in the mindset of a teenager from a poor family in rural Guatemala. But FAM works to instill this desire in our students and equips them with tools to envision a future where they can become professionals, serve their community, and improve living conditions for themselves and their families.

Every year, 12th graders take both aptitude and vocational interest tests. They also participate in individual interviews with a guidance counselor—who is also a member of our board—to discuss their results, assess their academic strengths and areas for improvement, and identify realistic paths in higher education. Students are encouraged to explore programs and scholarships for both college and technical degrees, based on what's available and attainable.

Starting in 2026, we hope to begin this process earlier—by 10th or 11th grade—to allow more time for students to explore their options and make informed, life-shaping decisions.
